(a) Alex is in the business of selling and buying second hand vehicles. The vehicles are usually displayed at a large yard located at Ngong Road in Nairobi. The owner of the car, Max, had left it with Alex with instructions that Alex was to obtain "good Offers" but that Alex was not to accept any offer without consulting with Max. Unfortunately Max had forgotten the Cars Logbook in the car's glove compartment. Using this document and pretending to be Max, Alex sold the car to Janet. Janet paid the full purchase price in cash. She also obtained from Alex (who was pretending to be Max) the car's logbook together with a transfer agreement. Janet did not however drive away the car on that day as she was travelling to naivasha. On the same day in the afternoon, Max came and took away the car telling Alex that he had changed his mind and that he was no longer interested in selling it. Upon returning janet made several attempts to collect the car from Alex. She has now discovered what transpired but is not sure what to do.
